

WHAT TO BRING

Potluck dish for Friday night, if you wish to participate, light jacket, shorts or swim suit if you want to swim in the river, feed and water bucket for your horse, manure fork to clean your horses area before you leave, trail snacks, lunches, and water, camera, money for drawing, quarters for shower, sunscreen, a sense of humor and a huge smile.

DIRECTIONS

If you are coming from the South, take Hwy 99 to the Oroville area, take the Feather River Canyon Highway 70 about an hour and a half, and follow it to the turn to Greenville on Highway 89 (not towards Quincy) along the river into the Indian Valley and take the right turn to Taylorsville, go through town and over the bridge on the river, the County Campground is on the right and the Rodeo Grounds is on your left.

Coming from North of Red Bluff, take I-5 to Red Bluff Antelope Blvd. exit left onto Antelope Blvd, go through town to the Hwy 36 Lassen Park turn left go about 2 hours. Travel toward Chester and before you come into Chester turn right toward Lake Almanor go through Greenville and Crescent Mills and just after Crescent Mills turn left toward Taylorsville and follow the directions above.

Coming from 395, take Hwy 70 toward Quincy, go through Quincy and turn right at the Greenville wye, follow the highway along the river to the Taylorsville sign and turn right, the Rodeo grounds is about 5 miles. If you get to Crescent Mills you have gone too far.
