From HWY 108 East towards Sonora: Take the Mono Way/108 Business Exit. Turn Right onto Mono Way. At next stoplight, turn right onto Tuolumne Road. Drive 1.8 miles and turn right onto Wards Ferry Road. Travel 4.5 miles down Wards Ferry to the Ranch Sign. There will be TT signs to help guide at the ranch. Turn left onto the ranch driveway. Follow the signs to the staging/camping area.

#### CAMPING

Camping is \$35 for the weekend. You may come in on Friday after 12:00PM (noon) and must leave Sunday night. There will be water available for horses. Bring hoses and hose splitters for sharing. No hosing of horses. Bring portable corrals, hot fence or high line supplies. No shavings allowed on the ground. If you are hauling in for day rides, it will be \$5/day.

## RANCH DETAILS

All dogs must be leashed at all times or contained at your trailer. No dogs allowed in the common area at registration or dinner. Cellular service is spotty. There is riding area in the field where camping is at. No riding outside of the camp area unless on the competitive trail.

#### EVENT SPECIFICS

Please mail pre-entries by the published date. All pre-entry riders will get preferred ride out time, no exceptions. Get your entries in early so you can get your ride time secured. Check in will start at 6PM on Friday evening. Saturday ride: 5 miles with 10 obstacles. Sunday ride: 3-4 miles with 7 obstacles. Awards 1-3rd place. Ribbons or horse treats for 4-6th place. You must ride both days to qualify for Overall Low Point Buckles.

## SATURDAY EVENTS

Potluck on Saturday night in the main common area will be Taco Bar. Please bring your favorite fixings to share at the taco bar (meats, beans, salsa, cheese, sour cream, avocado, lettus, tortillas, chips, etc)
