

**California State Horseman's Association - Trail Trials
State Championship Event 2026**

DIRECTIONS to Stone Cellar, a private campground

From Sacramento:

Hwy 50 East. Turn LEFT on ICE HOUSE RD.

From Tahoe/Reno:

Hwy 50 West. Turn RIGHT on ICE HOUSE Rd.

From Hwy 50, travel north on Ice House Road approximately 25 miles **toward Loon Lake Campground**. There is no physical address for Stone Cellar. Ice House Store is about halfway between Highway 50 and camp and is your only opportunity for ice, fuel or other supplies.

To get you to within a few miles of Stone Cellar, you can put **Loon Lake Campground** in your GPS (you *must* use Loon Lake CAMPGROUND, not just Loon Lake or you end up on the wrong road with no turn around opportunity!) The right turn on to Stone Cellar is a few miles prior to the Loon Lake Campground.

IMPORTANT!!! From Hwy 50, you will stay on Ice House Rd for Apx. 25 miles. Ice House Road veers to the right at Wentworth Springs Road TWICE! **Stay RIGHT each time!**

While you are on Ice House Rd, some landmarks you'll pass are Ice House Reservoir, Robb's Resort, and then at approximately Mile Marker 23, there is a power station/dam on the left. Shortly after the power dam is the **RIGHT** turn that keeps you on Ice House Road which is also marked as the way to Loon Lake Campground. The Trail Trial and CSHA signs will be out.

Watch for ribbons and signs for the next **right turn** into Stone Cellar (just after Mile Marker 24). The turn is at Forest Service Road 13N20 but the sign is hard to see so just look for Trail Trial flags and signs.

After turning off of Ice House Rd, its about 2 miles on a dirt road and thru the red gates at Stone Cellar. Go slow as there are some decent ruts/holes. DRIVE ESPECIALLY SLOW (no dust!) thru the RV and cabin area all the way back to the big meadow which is our camp. Also drive slow thru the meadow to your camp spot. Please face your rig out toward the way you came in if parking in the middle.

Please look at your maps and apps before heading up with a trailer. If you miss the turns on Ice House Rd it's very difficult to turn around and cell service is spotty.
